- **ARRIVE AT STADIUM: 12:45-1:00p.m.**

FOOTBALL GAME POLICIES

- **The band is to sit together at all times. No other individuals are permitted in the band’s designated seating area.**
- **There is to be NO EATING OR DRINKING IN UNIFORM. A cold bottle of water will be provided to each band member at the conclusion of the halftime performance. Eat something BEFORE dressing for the performance!**
- **Always take good care of your uniform. Be sure to hang it up in the garment bag immediately upon removal.**

Parents or friends who are picking up band members upon their dismissal may call the band office answering machine to confirm our dismissal time before leaving home. If the message on the machine makes no mention of the performance in question, the dismissal time on the itinerary is still accurate.
