President Cindi Hildreth opened the meeting and thanked everyone for their attendance.

Band Director's Report – Kevin Zaczekiewicz

- The Salisbury Christmas Parade went very well.
- Marching Band uniforms will be collected this Friday 12/9. Hat boxes should be cleaned out.
- A refund check has been received from Hershey Park. Each student will be reimbursed \$11.00.
- Mr. Zaczekiewicz requested that the walls of his office be repainted.
- The cost of a new Chapter Champions sign would be approximately \$400.00. A line could also be painted onto the existing sign. This will be further discussed.
- The Holiday Concert is scheduled for 12/20. Attendees are asked to bring canned food to be donated to the Maryland Food Bank. A Basketball game is also scheduled for that night but Mr. Zaczekiewicz will try to get that re-scheduled. Ladies are expected to wear black stockings with their concert dresses. The guys will need a pleated tuxedo shirt, black socks, and black dress shoes.
- On 12/21, the students will perform an in-school concert. Lifetouch will then take photos of all band members in their concert uniforms. As discussed at a previous meeting, Colorguard members will also be photographed and included in the yearbook. Advisor Mr. Marquez is not sure if they can give a whole page to the Colorguard.
